RULES & REGULATIONS:

1. Please re-read the rules and regulations so that we will not have any misunderstandings on the day of the show.
2. All exhibitors must be members of The Kingston & District Poultry & Pet Stock Association. Single membership is \$5.00 and family membership is \$10.00. Membership fees must accompany entry form.
3. Exhibitors fee will be \$1.50 per bird or rabbit and \$4.50 per trio. Fee must accompany entry form. Please make cheque or money order payable to the Kingston & District Poultry & Pet Stock Association.
4. Entries must be postmarked before Sept. 12th, 2022. Mail entry forms and fees to:

NO PHONE-IN ENTRIES, NO LATE ENTRIES, NO EMAIL ENTRIES.
5. Classes: All recognized and non-recognized breeds and varieties are accepted. Please list Breed, Variety, Gender, and Age on entry form.
Poultry: A (cock), B (hen), C (cockerel), D (pullet), OT (old trio), YT (young trio).
Pigeon: A (cock), B (hen), C (young cock), D (young hen), E (yearling cock), F (yearling hen). Yearlings must have 2021 bands, young birds must have 2022 bands.
Waterfowl/Turkey: A (old male), B (old female), C (young male), D (young female), OT (old trio), YT (young trio).
Rabbit: A (old buck), B (old doe), C (young buck), D (young doe).
6. Building opens at 8:00AM on September 25th. Stock must be cooped by 9:30AM. Judging starts at 10:00AM. There will be cooping in allowed on Saturday September 24th, from 7:00-9:00PM. Please notify the Show Chairman if you want to coop in on Saturday evening. All birds must be removed from the Poultry building at the completion of the show on September 25th.
7. Exhibitors are responsible for supplying feed and water to their entries.
8. Cash specials will be offered by the KDPPSA in classes where a minimum of 10 entries are entered, as per APA and NPA Standard classifications. Trophies and Awards will be presented to Overall Champions. Awards are presented at the discretion of the Committee. The KDPPSA is not responsible for awards offered by Individuals or Breed clubs. Complete list of awards will be posted on day of show.
9. There will be no cooping out until the show chairperson gives the OK!
10. Unhealthy stock will be removed from the building at the discretion of the Show Committee.
11. Those 18 and under may show as Junior exhibitors. Junior entries will be judged in the Open show, then also judged separately for Junior awards. All Junior exhibitors must be present on the day of the show to compete for awards, and must be capable of handling their own entries.
12. American Poultry Association show rules (available from the APA web site, at www.kdppsa.ca, and posted in the show hall) will also apply.
13. Photographs of winning entries may be taken and posted, along with the exhibitor's name, on the KDPPSA web site and/or submitted for publication in poultry newspapers. If you would prefer that this not be done with your entries please note this on your entry form.
14. All public health measures in place at the time of the show must be followed by all exhibitors and visitors.
15. We will use every precaution to prevent loss or mishap but will not be held responsible if it should occur.
