On June 16th, the Kingston and District club held its annual show at the Odessa Fairgrounds, Odessa, Ontario. Cliff Pepper of Dashwood, Ontario placed the Poultry and Waterfowl, while I judged the Pigeon classes.

Thirteen exhibitors showed 275 entries at this spring show. Champion Largefowl was a

black Australorp hen for Reg Watson, Reg also had the Best Opposite Sex Largefowl with a light Brahma cock. Best of Breeds are as follows: Heinz Merz had the best Brahma with a dark hen and the best Welsummer with a hen. Reg Watson had the best Cochin on a black hen, best Rock with a white cock and best Australorp with the black hen. Bill Bracken had the best Rhode Island Red on a hen, best Orpington with a buff hen, and best Hamburg with a silver spangled hen. Best Wyandotte was shown by Alan Benn, a white cock. Vince Pople had the best Cornish on a white cock and Del Gibson had the best O.E. Game with his B.B. Red cock. Frank Goodfellow had the best Leghorn with a S.C. white hen.

A total of 137 bantams were shown, O.E. Games being the largest class with 35, mostly black reds, 14 cocks and 13 hens. Champion Bantam was a black red O.E. Game hen shown by Walt Christmas. Best Opposite Sex Bantam was a white Plymouth Rock cockerel shown by Frank Goodfellow. Reg Watson had the best Rosecomb on a black hen, best Wyandotte with a white hen and best Mille Fleur with a hen. A buff hen was the best Brahma for Heinz Merz. Alan Benn had the best Cochin with a black hen, best Leghorn with

a dark brown cock and best

Cornish on a white laced red hen. Bill Bracken had the best Sebright with a silver cock and best R.I. Red on a cock. Frank Goodfellow had the best Rock on a white cockerel and Vince Pople the top Modern on a silver duckwing cock. Walt Christmas had the best O.E. Game with his black red hen.

Champion Waterfowl was a white Call drake shown by Reg Watson and Best Opposite Sex was an African goose, an entry of Vince Pople.

In the Junior Division, it was a black Australorp cock by Dana Pople winning Best Standard. Best Opposite Sex was a black Australorp hen by Mitchell Austin. Mitchell also had the Best and Best Oppo-

site Sex Jr. Bantam on a black red O.E. Game hen and a black O.E. Game cock respectively.

Pigeon classes consisted of 61 birds in 14 breeds. Bill Harrison had the Champion Pigeon on a black L.F.C.L. Tumbler hen. Reserve Champ. was a grizzle Dragoon hen for Robby Copeland. Robby also had the Best Opposite Sex Pigeon of show with his blue Fantail cock. Best Junior Pigeon of the show was a blue bar Chinese Owl hen shown by Cassandra Bracken. Dana Pople captured the Best Opposite Sex with a blue bar Chinese Owl cock.


