

The Kingston & District Poultry & Pet Stock Association Show, 2026 APA Provincial Meet

SUNDAY June 7, 2026.

Location: Poultry Building on the Odessa Fairgrounds, Odessa, Ontario

RULES & REGULATIONS:

1. Please re-read the rules and regulations so that we will not have any misunderstandings on the day of the show.
2. All exhibitors must be members of The Kingston & District Poultry & Pet Stock Association. Single membership is \$10.00 and family membership is \$15.00. Membership fees must accompany entry.
3. Those 18 and under may show as Junior exhibitors. Junior classes will be judged separately, but compete for special awards. All Junior exhibitors must be present on the day of the show to compete for awards, and must be capable of handling their own entries.
4. Entries must be received by May 25, 2026 either by email to kdppsa@kdppsa.ca or mail to: Frank Goodfellow, PO Box 24, Parham ON, K0H 2K0.
5. Entry fee will be \$3.00 per bird or rabbit and \$9.00 per trio. Fee must accompany entry. Please pay by e-transfer to kdppsa@kdppsa.ca or make cheque or money order payable to the Kingston & District Poultry & Pet Stock Association. Double coops are not available at our show.
6. A complete, signed, entry form must accompany all entries (a scan or photo is acceptable by email).
7. Classes: All recognized and non-recognized breeds and varieties are accepted. Please list Breed, Variety, Gender, and Age on entry form.
Poultry: A (cock), B (hen), C (cockerel), D (pullet), OT (old trio), YT (young trio).
Pigeons: A (cock), B (hen), C (young cock), D (young hen).
Waterfowl/Turkeys/Guineas: A (old male), B (old female), C (young male), D (young female), OT (old trio), YT (young trio).
Rabbits: A (senior buck), B (senior doe), C (junior buck), D (junior doe), E (intermediate buck), F (intermediate doe). Note: junior rabbits are less than 6 months of age; intermediates are 6-9 months. Intermediate classes available for breeds with mature weights over 9 pounds; others junior/senior only.
8. Rabbits will be table judged. Please bring your rabbits in suitable show carriers and be prepared to bring them to the judging table when the appropriate class is called.
9. Exhibitors are responsible for supplying feed and water to their entries.
10. Building opens at 8:00AM on June 7th. Stock must be cooped by 9:30AM. Judging starts at 10:00AM. There will be cooping in allowed on Saturday June 6th, from 7:00- 9:00PM. Please notify the Show Chairman if you want to coop in on Saturday evening. All birds must be removed from the Poultry building at the completion of the show on June 7th.
11. There will be no cooping out until the show chairperson gives the OK.
12. Unhealthy stock will be removed from the building at the discretion of the Show Committee.
13. Cash specials will be offered by the KDPPSA in classes where a minimum of 10 entries are entered, as per APA and NPA Standard classifications. Trophies and Awards will be presented to Overall Champions. Awards are presented at the discretion of the Committee. The KDPPSA is not responsible for awards offered by Individuals or Breed clubs. A complete list of awards will be posted on the day of the show.
14. American Poultry Association and American Bantam Association show rules will also apply.
15. Photographs of winning entries may be taken and posted, along with the exhibitor's name, on the KDPPSA web site. If you would prefer that this not be done with your entries please note this on your entry form.
16. We will use every precaution to prevent loss or mishap but will not be held responsible if it should occur.
