RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All Exhibitors in the open classes must pay a \$5.00 Membership Fee. No membership is required for juniors aged 13 and under.
2. Entry fee in all classes is 50 cents per bird or rabbit.
3. All stock must be healthy or will be removed from the building.
4. Stock must be cooped by 9:30 a.m. on Saturday, July 25, 2026 and remain until 3:00 pm the following day, or at the Show Chairman's discretion or forfeit prize money.
5. Judging will start at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday.
6. Entries and entry fees must be received by July 16, 2026. No late entries accepted. The entry form and a cheque for the fees can be mailed to the show chairman, or a scan or photo of the entry form and payment by e-transfer may be sent to kdppsa@kdppsa.ca. For email entries, the signed paper version of the form must be handed in when you coop in. ONLY the first 600 entries can be accepted. Make cheques payable to: The Kingston and District Poultry and Pet Stock Association.

11. Prize Money – 1st \$5.00, 2nd \$3.00, 3rd \$2.50
12. Any parties interfering with the Judges, directly or indirectly, will forfeit their prize money in said class.
13. In showing stock in A.O.C. and A.V. class, please state what colour and breed your entry is. If warranted, classes will be added. If you do not indicate the breed and colour in these classes, it is impossible to have this done before judging commences.
14. Exhibitors are only allowed three birds per section.
15. Poultry will be judged against the American Poultry Association Standard of Perfection. Pigeons will be judged against the National Pigeon Association Standard.
16. Backyard class is intended for birds that are not a recognized breed. This class will be judged on condition.
